A non competitive event for classic vehicles using tulip directions to navigate a route carefully chosen to visit some of Buckinghamshire's most interesting places.



Using carefully selected quiet minor roads ideal for classic cars the route runs through North Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire. Starting at the Claydon Estate where entrants will sign on and relax before the start with refreshments which are included in the entry fee. The route continues through good driving roads into Oxfordshire and runs down into the Thames valley with some spectacular views and passes a range of luncheon opportunities at some very good inns.

The Route will finish at Nuffield Place near Wallingford, the retirement home of Herbert Morris, one of the most remarkable men of the 20th Century. The house typifies early 20th-century taste and thrift; revealing the home life of Lord and Lady Nuffield. Even with a fortune behind them, they still enjoyed the simpler things in life. Their home and personal possessions are just as they left them, giving visitors a true experience of how they would have lived their lives. The house is open to visitors (N.T. members free) and the grounds provide plenty of space for picnics if you haven't stopped at one of the many fine inns passed en route.
